CURLING: World Team Rankings points list suspension extended

For immediate release: Tuesday 8 September 2020

Perth, Scotland – The World Curling Federation, following consultation, has extended the suspension of the World Team Rankings point list until 30 November 2020.

The initial suspension — caused by the continuing challenges surrounding the COVID-19 global pandemic, specifically surrounding international travel restrictions — was due to end on 31 October 2020.

However, as travel restrictions remain in place for a number of countries, it was felt that extending the points suspension was the only fair option.

This decision will be reviewed on a regular basis to determine whether the points suspension will continue beyond November, and further updates will be provided where necessary.
